

Washington Math & Science Institute Dress Code

- ◆ Bottoms: Khaki or Navy trousers, skirts, shorts and jumpers. (Logos, denim, cargo pockets and painter pants/shorts are prohibited).
- ◆ Long socks worn with shorts and skirts need to be uniform colors.
- ◆ Tops: Red, White or Navy collared shirts with long or short sleeves.
- ◆ Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
- ◆ Plain Black or Brown Belts (leather or leather like) void of any writing, brand name, trim or art work are to be worn with garments with belt loops .
- ◆ All garments must meet the adopted district policy guidelines and not be more than 3 inches above the knee. Shorts, pants, skirts and jumpers will be hemmed. (pants hemmed to not drag the floor).
- ◆ Students may not tie sweaters or jackets around their waist.
- ◆ Bandanas or other head scarves are unacceptable and will not be worn while students are at school.
- ◆ Fridays will be school spirit days. Students will have the choice of wearing a school logo shirt or uniform shirt with uniform bottoms or denim bottoms void of any writing, brand name, trim or art work.
- ◆ Alternative dress days will be designated by the building principal (i.e. party days, picture day, special event days).

When the weather is cold students may wear:

- ◆ A **Red, Navy, or White** turtle neck, round or v-neck top with long sleeves under their short sleeve polo.
- ◆ Sweaters (pull over or cardigan) worn as a top garment must be **Red, Navy or White** void of any writing, brand name, trim or art work.
- ◆ A pair of **Red, Navy or White** leggings under their uniform skirts or dresses.
- ◆ A **Red, Navy or White** jacket during winter months void of any writing, brand name, trim or art work. **IMPORTANT!** Hoods must be removed from the head while students are inside the school building.
- ◆ Coats worn to school that are not **Red, Navy or White** must be removed while students are inside the building.
- ◆ All Scarves must be removed while students are inside the building.

Students who violate the school dress code are issued consequences through the Office.
