◆ **General guidelines**

All standard attire clothing may be purchased only one size larger than the student currently wears to allow for growth. Logos, artwork, or embroidery must be less than 2" by 2". No oversized clothing is allowed. No tight fitting clothing is allowed. All clothing must be hemmed. No torn, cut, or ripped clothing is allowed. All Standard Attire clothing will follow the MISD Student Code of Conduct dress code. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Students that violate the dress code are issued consequences through the Assistant Principals' office. **Any item not specifically addressed will be left to the discretion of the building administrator.**

Before You Buy

Parents are ultimately responsible for making sure their child follows the Standard Attire Policy. If you are in doubt or have any questions about the Standard Attire Policy, please call 689-1250.

◆ **Pants, shorts, and skirts** are to be a solid tan or navy blue color Khaki twill fabric in the style of fitted (not baggy) straight legged dress pants worn at the waist. Shorts/skirts must be no more than three inches above the knee while standing, measured from the top of the slit on a skirt if present. **NO CARGO POCKETS OR CARPENTER STYLES.** No stretch material. No denim or jean material.



◆ **Belts** must be solid black or brown leather and must be worn in the belt loops with pants, skirts, and shorts that have belt loops. No visible brands, logos, studded or jeweled belts.



◆ **Shirts** must be polo style or oxford style collared shirts, in solid white, maroon, navy, or gray. Shirts must be long enough to stay tucked in. Shirts must be buttoned. No more than the top two buttons on a shirt may be left unbuttoned. Only a white, navy, maroon or gray T-shirt/undershirt or turtleneck may be worn under the uniform shirt.



◆ During cool weather a solid white, maroon, gray, or navy **sweatshirt** or **sweater** may be worn over the uniform shirt with the uniform shirt collar showing. No hoods, zippers, or logos other than the Lee Rebel Logo. Coats and jackets may only be worn before and after school. Coats and jackets must be in lockers upon entering the building.

◆ On Fridays and/or Spirit Days, a Rebel Spirit Shirt or college shirt (**NO JERSEYS**) may be substituted for the regular uniform shirt. Shirts must be tucked in at all times and worn with standard attire pants, skirts, shorts, overalls, or jumpers. Spirit shirts do not have to be collared. No homemade spirit shirts or pants will be allowed.

If parents are not financially able to provide standard attire for their child, resources from private individuals, local businesses, and the school district will be used to provide a uniform conforming to the Standard Attire Policy.
