A student in Grades 6-12 must be given credit for a LOTE course in which he or she has had no prior instruction if the student scores 80% on a criterion-referenced test. If a student is given credit in a subject on the basis of an examination, the school district must enter the examination score on the student's transcript.

Examination scores for high school courses will be used in computing the student's grade point average and rank in class. Failing credit by examination scores will not be recorded on the transcript. A student in Grades 6-12 will be given credit for a LOTE course in which he or she had some prior instruction, if the student scores 70% on a criterion referenced test for the applicable course.
