### **Unique to MISD:**

The Academy is 1 of 3 in Texas, but is the only to offer engineering and career ready paths. Students earn 9+ hours towards their Energy Tech certificate or Associates of Applied Engineering. Certification in Basic Operating Procedure and Safeland is provided. Real world experience through field trips and guest speakers from the industry is provided. Students must enter in the 9th grade.

### **School History:**

By the late 1950's & early 60's as a result of the West Texas oil boom, the high school population had grown too large for the single Midland High School campus to accommodate. A \$3.5 million dollar bond was passed to build Lee High School, which was acclaimed both regionally and nationally as a giant step into justifying the cost of air conditioning in public schools. Its unique design included 7 pods arranged around a central courtyard. The facility won top architectural awards and changed the future of architecture for public schools.
