

Burnet Elementary Standard Attire Policy

Short or long sleeve polo style shirts (knit with collar)

- White, red, grey or black;
- Shirts can be solid or striped in the named colors.
- Logo, label or insignia must be less than two inches by two inches.
- Shirts must be tucked in.

Short or long sleeve polo style dresses (knit with collar)

- White, red, grey or black;
- Dresses can be solid or striped in the named colors.
- Logo, label or insignia must be less than two inches by two inches.
- The hemline of dresses must be no more than three inches from the top of the knee including any slits in the hemlines.

Pants, shorts, capris, skirts, skorts or jumpers

- Khaki or black;
- No denim or denim-like material except on designated days;
- No cargo, carpenter or painter style pants, shorts or capris;
- Hemlines on shorts, skirts or dresses must be no more than three inches from the top of the knee including any slit in the hemlines.
- Logo, label or insignia must be less than two inches by two inches.
- Bottoms must be worn at the waist at all times – no sagging.

Cold weather attire

- White, red, grey or black sleeve turtle necks or crew neck shirts may be worn under collared shirts.
- White, red, grey or black leggings may be worn under girls' dresses or skirts.
- Solid colored sweaters or sweatshirts without hoods (pull over or cardigan) may be worn as a top garment as long as it is white, red, grey or black. Collars of shirts must be showing and no garments may be worn around the shoulders or waist.
- All outerwear is acceptable but must be removed while students are inside the building.

Accessories

- Black or brown belts (no decorations, rivets, spikes, or designs) are required when there are belt loops on the garment for all students in grades 2-6.
- Socks with shorts, skirts, capris, jumpers, dresses, or skorts must be a solid uniform color.
- Shoes will continue to follow MISD dress code policy. Athletic shoes are strongly recommended.

Acceptable options

- On Fridays, students may wear plain jeans (denim), pants, shorts, skirts, capris or jumper (no designs, writings, tears, holes, logos or cargo type jeans) that are MISD dress code acceptable with a spirit shirt for either Burnet, Lee High or Midland High.
- On Mondays, students may wear a college shirt with their khaki or black shorts, pants, skirts, capris or jumper.
- No Uniform Days will be held on designated days throughout the school year.
- Standard Attire for students enrolled in Prekindergarten and Head Start is optional.

Burnet Elementary follows Midland ISD dress code. Appropriateness of any clothing or other accessory not specifically addressed will be left up to the discretion of the building administration. Items found to be disruptive to the learning environment by the campus administration will be addressed accordingly. All standard attire guidelines are subject to change at the discretion of the principal.
