<p align="center">Tops</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be a navy, red or white YWLA polo in either short or long sleeve. • Undershirts (short or long sleeve) may be worn under uniform polo BUT must be solid navy, white, black or red. • YWLA school spirit shirts can be worn on any day except the dress uniform day. (PTA Store) • YWLA Club shirts are FRIDAY only. <i>Examples of club shirts: STUCO, DI, Robotics, Choir, Orchestra, Speech and Debate, Interact, etc.</i> 	<p align="center">Pants/Shorts/Skirts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skirts must be navy or YWLA plaid with pleats. • Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 3” above the knee. • May not be ripped or torn. • Pants should be dress or dockers style, not jeggings. • Leggings may be worn under uniform skirt, and they must be solid white, black, red, or navy. No decorations, holes, or lace. 	<p align="center">Sweaters/Sweatshirts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • YWLA sweatshirts ARE approved to be worn in the classroom except on dress uniform days. • The only approved jacket worn in the classroom is a YWLA jacket. Other jackets must be kept in the backpack during classes. • Solid color cardigan-style sweaters are allowed in navy, gray, red, or white. • Hoodies ARE NOT allowed on campus at any time for middle school. • High School students may only wear their class-created hoodies. 	<p align="center">Shoes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School appropriate shoes only. No house shoes, no flip-flops, no slides. • Black dress shoes are required on dress uniform days only (no sneakers (Vans/Converse) or boots on dress uniform day, black dress shoes should be solid black). <p align="center">Accessories</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School-appropriate accessories only. No gloves, costume headwear, bandanas, or costume pieces unless it is a theme day.
<p align="center">The Week in Dress Code</p> <p>Monday: YWLA polo or YWLA school spirit shirt and navy/plaid bottoms and appropriate shoes</p> <p>Tuesday: YWLA polo or YWLA school spirit shirt and navy/plaid bottoms and appropriate shoes</p> <p>Wednesday: The DRESS uniform and black dress shoes.</p> <p>Thursday: YWLA polo or YWLA school spirit shirt and navy/plaid bottoms and appropriate shoes</p> <p>Friday: YWLA polo or YWLA or club, spirit shirt or college shirt and navy/plaid bottoms OR JEANS (rips below the knees ONLY) and appropriate shoes.</p>	<p align="center">Mandatory Leadership Dress Uniform worn each Wednesday and on special event days:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Button up white dress shirt. (short sleeve or long sleeve) • Navy sweater vest or red sweater vest. (optional blazer and cardigan) • Plaid cross tie. High schoolers will wear a long red tie. • Optional knee or ankle length socks or tights must be navy or white, SOLID color only. • Plaid skirt or solid navy skirt. • Black dress shoes (no sneakers or boots on dress uniform day) • High schoolers ONLY are approved to wear NAVY or BLACK DRESS PANTS instead of the plaid/navy skirt. NO JEGGINGS/LEGGINGS 		
<p>** If a student plays a sport for their home campus, they may only wear that school/sport spirit shirt, letter jacket, etc on game days. It is the responsibility of the athlete to provide the game schedule to administration.</p>	<p align="center">Uniform Infractions</p> <p align="center"><i>1st Infraction: 1 day lunch detention (day of)</i></p> <p align="center"><i>2nd Infraction: 2 days of lunch detention (day of and following day)</i></p> <p align="center"><i>3rd + Infraction: 1 day of after school detention 4:00-5:00 (following day)</i></p>
