ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS

Daily Attendance	<p>To ensure attendance credit is given, students MUST completed the following <i>daily</i>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ <u>Log Daily Attendance</u>: Students must log in to Google Classroom daily to read the daily agenda and access daily assignments & expectations. THEN, mark themselves PRESENT on the Daily Attendance task. <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ <u>Demonstrate Engagement</u>: Engagement is measured by completing one or more of the following: online curriculum lessons, submitted google classroom tasks, assignments, participating in virtual interactive meetings, tutorials, group discussions, teaching sessions, office hour communication... <p>Elementary: Help your student join the LIVE Virtual Teaching sessions with their teacher or watch the recordings posted if you are unable to attend (may affect attendance?)</p> <p>Secondary: Join the LIVE Virtual Teaching sessions with your teacher or watch the recordings posted if you are unable to attend (may affect attendance?) These are highly encouraged to keep students connected to teachers and peers</p>
Assignments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ <u>Completion</u>: ALL assignments are to be completed. This includes guided practice, independent practice, group tasks, discussion activities, etc.
Communicate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ <u>Get Help</u>: Teachers need to know when you are having trouble understanding a concept or assignment instructions. It is the responsibility of the student and/or parent to seek clarification and assistance when needed. ❑ <u>Email</u>: Copy your parent(s) on email communication with your teacher. Parents, help your child effectively communicate via email. ❑ <u>Conference</u>: Contact your teacher/your child's teacher with questions or attend open office hours for virtual support.

Establish Family At-Home Learning Expectations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">❑ As a family, discuss your expectations for At-Home Learning & create a written reminder to post in your designated learning space.❑ <u>Establish a Daily Routine</u>: Set a daily routine and learning schedule that works for your family.❑ <u>Designate a Learning Space</u>: Establish a quiet, well-lit place in your home where you/your student can learn and focus.❑ <u>Commit to Communicate</u>: Share and discuss learning, lesson goals, and upcoming assignments as a family.❑ <u>Accountability Check</u>: Ensure your student has turned in all assignments daily, Ask your child to show you a thread or email they have used to communicate with their teacher
Prepare to Communicate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">❑ <u>Update Parent Contact Information</u>: Check your Skyward Family Access to ensure phone and email contact is up to date. Update any information that is outdated.❑ <u>Subscribe to Guardian Summaries</u>: Opt to receive the weekly Google Classroom Guardian Summary email.
