



Midland Independent School District
Safety & Security Committee Meeting Minutes
June 7th, 2022

The MISD School Safety and Security Committee meeting was called to order at approximately 1:05 p.m. at the Midland ISD Administration Center, 615 W. Missouri, Midland, Texas, by the Chief of Police, Arthur Barclay.

Chief Barclay welcomed everyone to the meeting.

To begin this Safety & Security Committee meeting, Chief Barclay passed out copies of the updated MISD Emergency Operations Plan for the committee members to review. Highlighted for their attention was an update to the Active Shooter Response Plan which addresses contact strike team response to active shooting situations.

- The first speaker Deputy Chief Jayme Farmer of the Midland Fire Department was then introduced by Chief Barclay to begin his presentation

Deputy Chief Farmer addressed the following topics;

1. Active Shooter/Mass Casualty Incident Procedures.
 2. Midland Fire Department Tactical Medics Response to Active Shooter and Other Violent Incidents
- The second speaker Imogene Douglas Director of School Dept. of Health Services discussed:
 1. Stop the Bleed training
 2. Triage Training
 3. Narcan Opioid overdose treatment nasal spray that MISD Police Officers will have in their possession to be able to administer if required.
 - Lt. Brunner addressed the following topics:
 1. MISD Safety and Security Checks
 2. Great Vape Roundup Statistics
 - Committee members were given out the following handouts by Chief Barclay:
 1. Governor Greg Abbot's Safety and Security Directive to School Districts date June 1st,2022
 2. 2021 -2022 Offenses Compare to Previous 3year spreadsheet
 3. Analysis of MISD Offense Data (School Year 2021-2022)
 - In response to a question MISD Superintendent Dr. Ramsey commented regarding getting support to help with Mental Health concerns on campuses.
 - School Board President Bryan Murray asked a question related to Police response times to MISD campuses
 - Jennifer Carpenter (Parent) asked the following questions:
 - Can the School district hire off duty MPD officers to provide extra security for school campus?
 - Can the District install Metal detectors on the front door of each school campus?
 - Do all school campus teachers know what Threat Assessment Team is?
 - Can any State Trooper just walk down school hallways without permission from Administration?
 - Can school campuses have volunteer parents monitor school campus hallways and grounds?
 - Board member Tommy Bishop made a comment "Don't wait for something to happen to get the training, get the training before it happens so everyone can be prepared in case of an incident"
 - The meeting was adjourned by Chief Barclay at approximately 1:54 p.m. without the need to go into Executive session.
