Safety & Security Committee Meeting Minutes  
September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022

The MISD School Safety and Security Committee meeting was called to order at approximately 1:05 p.m. at the Midland ISD District Service Center, 615 W. Missouri, Midland, Texas, by the Emergency Management Coordinator, Mr. Tim Allen.
