

2021-2022 Carver Center Standard Attire Guidelines

Tops and dresses:

- Collared shirt/sweater/sweatshirt/dress:
 - Acceptable colors: Blue/navy, gray, gold/yellow, black, and white
 - All tops/dresses must have a collar or have a collared shirt underneath
 - Logos no larger than 2"x 2"
 - Must be an appropriate length (backside cannot show when seated)
 - **Hooded pullover sweatshirts are not allowed**
- Spirit and college shirts/t-shirts may be worn any day of the week:
 - Carver Center or any MISD junior high/high school shirt
 - College/university shirt
 - Must be an appropriate length (backside cannot show when seated)

*Important note regarding jackets/coats: Jackets and coats (any outer layer with a full zip closure) will remain in backpacks or on hooks during the school day. *Please label all jackets and coats with your child's name!*

Shoes:

- No slides will be allowed for safety purposes
- On PE days, a student must wear athletic shoes appropriate for physical activity to school (**no change of shoes before PE will be allowed**)

Pants, skirts, and shorts:

- Acceptable colors: Navy, black, and khaki
- Guidelines:
 - Twill, khaki, or similar fabric
 - Shorts, skirts and dresses must be no shorter than the end of the fingertips when a student is standing straight with arms by their side, even if wearing leggings
- Denim pants or shorts may be worn on Friday. They must follow the MISD dress code guidelines.

Special Dress Days*:

- Picture Days – Students are not required to dress in Carver standard attire, but must follow MISD dress code guidelines.
- Campus Designated Theme or Holiday Dress Days – Students are not required to dress in Carver standard attire if they are participating in the theme or holiday dress attire, but must follow MISD dress code guidelines.
