

**MIDLAND FRESHMAN HIGH SCHOOL  
2021-2022 DRESS CODE**

The district's dress code teaches grooming and hygiene, prevents disruption, and minimizes safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided they comply with the following:

<b>SHIRTS/T-SHIRTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Tank tops, undershirts or muscle shirts are not allowed</li><li>● Revealing clothing and/or see-through material not allowed</li><li>● Low cut neckline, strapless, bare midriff, and/or revealing clothing not allowed</li></ul>
<b>SHORTS/SKIRTS/ PANTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Fingertip length on shorts and skirts</li><li>● Hips and buttocks must be covered</li><li>● Pants, jeans, shorts, and/or skirts must be worn above the hip bones (no sagging)</li><li>● No rip, tears, holes above fingertip length in pants, shorts, skirts, or jeans</li><li>● Clothing must be appropriately sized and remain at the waistline</li><li>● No leggings worn as pants</li><li>● Pajamas and sleepwear are not allowed.</li></ul>
<b>HOODS/HATS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Hats, hoods, beanies, bandanas, head-coverings, etc. cannot be worn in the classroom or school building</li></ul>
<b>FOOTWEAR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● House shoes and slippers are not allowed</li></ul>

**PROHIBITED CLOTHING**

Promotes or advertises violence, illegal drugs, alcohol, gangs, hate speech, profanity or pornography

Images or language that creates a hostile or intimidating environment based on any protected class or consistently marginalized group

If the principal determines that a student's grooming or clothing violates the school's dress code, the student will be given an opportunity to correct the problem at school. If not corrected, the student may be assigned to in-school suspension for the remainder of the day, until the problem is corrected, or until a parent or designee brings an acceptable change of clothing to the school. Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action in accordance with the Student code of Conduct.
